

ORDER No 301 of 22 December 2006

on the approval of the Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Rule concerning the procedures of registering activities of primary products direct selling, of retail sale and food production

ISSUER: NATIONAL SANITARY VETERINARY AND FOOD SAFETY AUTHORITY

Having regard to the provisions of Article 10 (b) of the Government Ordinance No 42/2004 on the organization of the sanitary veterinary and food safety activity, approved with amendments and additions by means of Law No 215/2004, with the subsequent amendments and additions,

considering the provisions of the Emergency Government Ordinance No 97/2001 on the regulation of food production, transportation and marketing, approved with amendments and additions by means of Law No 57/2002,

considering the provisions of the Government Decision No 925/2005 on the approval of the Rules regarding the official controls performed to ensure the verification of compliance with feed and food law, animal health and animal welfare rules, representing the transposition in the national law of the provisions of Regulation No 882/2004/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union,

pursuant to the Government Decision No 130/2006 on the organization and functioning of the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority and of the establishments from its subordination,

having read the Approving Report No 87.478 of 21 December 2006, drawn up by the Directorate for Hygiene and Veterinary Public Health and by the Directorate-General for Food Safety within the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority,

the president of the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority hereby issues the following order:

Article 1

The Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Rule concerning the procedures of registering activities of primary products direct selling, of retail sale and food production, laid down in the annex to this Order, is hereby approved.

Article 2

The Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Rule provided for in Article 1 was drawn up in view of establishing the procedure of sanitary veterinary and food safety registration of the activities in primary products direct selling establishments or retail establishments, according to the provisions of the Government Decision No 925/2005 on the approval of the Rules regarding the official controls performed to ensure the verification of compliance with feed and food law, animal health and animal welfare rules, representing the transposition in the national law of the provisions of Regulation No 882/2004/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union.

Article 3

The sanitary veterinary and food safety rule provided for in Article 1 does not apply to primary products obtained by private producers and destined for own consumption.

Article 4

The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorates, respectively that in the municipality of Bucharest, shall carry out the provisions of this Order.

Article 5

The National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority shall control the implementation of the provisions of this Order.

Article 6

This Order shall be published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, and shall enter into force 10 days after its publication.

ANNEX

SANITARY VETERINARY AND FOOD SAFETY RULE

concerning the procedures of registering activities of primary products direct selling, of retail sale and food production

CHAPTER I

Primary products direct selling

1. Definitions

Article 1

These provisions establish the definitions regarding the activities of primary products direct selling, as well as the procedure for sanitary veterinary registration of the activities of primary products direct selling.

Article 2

Within the meaning of this Chapter, the subsequent terms and expressions are defined as follows:

a) sanitary veterinary registration – registering establishments producing foodstuffs of animal origin, other than those authorized from the veterinary point of view, in the lists of establishments with primary products direct selling, by the county sanitary veterinary authority, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, pursuant to a written request from the legal representative of the establishment;

b) activities subject to sanitary veterinary registration – activities of direct selling of primary products of animal origin obtained from primary production, subject to sanitary veterinary registration and control;

c) sanitary veterinary registration document – the document issued by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, for the activities in the establishments subject to registration;

d) primary production – producing, stockfarming or making primary products, including animals bred for slaughter, milk production, as well as hunting or fishing.

Details about the activities related to primary production:

(i) activities from the stockfarming location, including transportation of domestic animals towards a certain destination;

(ii) stockfarming for food production, transportation of animals to slaughterhouse or transportation of animals from one farm to another;

(iii) transportation, storage and handling of primary products at the farm or at the production place, provided that their nature is not modified;

(iv) production, breeding and harvest of snails at the farm, their transportation to a processor or to a marketing place;

(v) for the products from fishing and hunting, their transportation, for supplying primary products, from the production place to another location, including transportation from the production place to a processor;

(vi) milk production and storage at the farm and its transportation to a collection centre;

(vii) egg production and collection at own farm, except for the egg packaging operations;

(viii) fishing, handling of fishery products, without substantially changing their nature on board, except for factory ships and cooler vessels, and their transportation to the first land establishment, including to the fish market auction. This shall also include fishing, handling and transportation of freshwater fish;

(ix) production, raising and harvest of fish in fish farming sites and its transportation towards an established destination;

(x) production, raising and harvest of live bivalve molluscs, as well as their transportation to a purification centre;

(xi) hunting, killing and evisceration of game on the spot and its transportation towards an establishment approved for the handling of wild game;

(xii) harvest of wild snails and their transportation to a processor;

(xiii) all the activities related to the extraction and keeping of bee honey, harvest of other products produced by bees, including the keeping of melliferous products, even though this activity allows hives to be distant from the producer's keeping place, except for honey destined for collection and/or packaging at a processor;

e) primary products – the products resulting from primary production, including the products obtained by stockfarming and those from hunting or fishing. The category of primary products destined for direct selling contains:

1. poultry meat or rabbit meat derived from animals subject to on-farm slaughter;

2. furred game or game bird, eviscerated or not, obtained by hunters, except for wild game meat;

3. fish and fishery products, including live bivalve molluscs from fishing or aquaculture, that can be partially processed, scaled, fin-removed and frozen;

4. milk as feedstock collected directly from the farm;

5. eggs obtained in own farms, without the marking or packaging activities;

6. extracted bee honey and other harvested products produced by bees, their storage, except for the treatments for heating or packaging the bee honey;

f) primary products direct selling – direct supply from the production place of primary products towards the final consumer or their supply in small quantities towards retail establishments in town or in a neighbouring town, including their storage and handling at the production place. Direct selling also includes supply by the producer directly to the final consumer of primary products in small quantities, during fairs, markets, exhibitions, religious holidays etc., periodically organized by the competent authorities in this field;

The expression “primary products direct selling” does not include the activities of delivery from the production place of primary products in view of the subsequent processing to the establishments authorized from the veterinary point of view;

g) small quantities – the following quantities of products of animal origin:

1. milk as feedstock – up to 1.000 l/week;

2. fresh fish – up to 100 kg/transport for sea-caught fish and 10 kg/transport for freshwater fish;

3. wild furred game or game bird – up to one unit for large game and 10 units for little game of the allotted hunting quota;

4. poultry meat or lagomorphs meat obtained in farm up to 2.000 bird heads and 1.000 rabbits/year;
5. snails and live bivalve molluscs – up to 20 kg/week;
6. eggs – from farms with maximum 50 hens;
- h) official retention – the procedure through which the competent authority imposes that products of animal origin should not be moved or falsified until a decision regarding their destination is made; this includes storage by the processors active in the field of products of animal origin according to the directions of competent authorities;
- i) small producer – the natural or legal person carrying out activities of primary products direct selling.

2. Sanitary veterinary registration of activities of primary products direct selling

Article 3

(1) Small producers carrying out activities of primary products direct selling provided for in Article 2 (e) must be registered by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(2) Sanitary veterinary registration of small producers carrying out activities of primary products direct selling is made by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, pursuant to a written request, drawn up by the owner, that must contain:

- a) name/address of the small producer/legal representative of the establishment;
- b) activity carried out;
- c) types and quantities of products subject to direct selling;
- d) location of primary products direct selling.

Article 4

(1) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall register the submitted request and shall check through official veterinarians the compliance with the sanitary veterinary conditions provided for in the current law, relating to primary production and primary products direct selling.

(2) Activities of primary products direct selling shall be registered in a special register by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorates, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, providing each small producer with a registration number preceded by the letters DS (direct selling), as well as a sanitary veterinary registration document, according to the model included in Annex 2.

Article 5

Small producers have the following duties:

- a) implementation and compliance with the measures intended to prevent contamination of primary products through air, water and soil by waste or veterinary medicinal products etc.;
- b) implementation and compliance with the measures regarding health and welfare of animals used to obtain the products intended for direct selling;
- c) proper hygienic maintenance of every equipment and facility used in the production process, including those used for the storage and handling of primary products;
- d) supply with drinking or clean water whenever necessary, to prevent contamination;
- e) ensuring that the staff handling primary products is in a good health status and has been trained concerning general hygiene rules;
- f) avoiding as much as possible the contamination of primary products by means of animals or other pests;
- g) prevention of introduction and spreading of zoonoses or zoonotic agents transmissible to humans by means of primary products;

- h) taking into consideration the results of the analyses made on samples taken from primary production or other feedstock significant for public health;
- i) use of forage additives and of veterinary medicinal products according to the law in this field;
- j) keeping the documentation relating to feed, veterinary medicinal products used in animal treatment etc.;
- k) filling in the registrations relating to the quantities of primary products delivered towards the final consumer, towards local establishments of retail sale or towards establishments authorised from the sanitary veterinary point of view.

Article 6

(1) If, after the checking carried out by the veterinary staff within the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, at the production place or that of primary products direct selling, failure to comply with the sanitary veterinary conditions provided for in the national law relating to primary production and primary products direct selling is established, a note shall be drawn up where all the deficiencies established, measures to be implemented, as well as time-limits for improving the deficiencies shall be written down, under the signature of the producer/legal representative of the establishment.

(2) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall monitor the activities of primary products direct selling and shall inform, where appropriate, the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority, upon its request.

(3) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall prohibit the activity of small producers carrying out activities of primary products direct selling when it shall, repeatedly, establish that they do not comply with the sanitary veterinary conditions established by the current law.

3. Controls and measures

Article 7

(1) All the activities of primary products direct selling are subject to the sanitary veterinary control carried out by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(2) The activities of primary products direct selling are subject to control whenever necessary, but at least once a year, at the production place or that of primary products direct selling, by the official veterinarians of the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(3) If, after two successive controls carried out by the official veterinarians of the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, or after the intimation from the buyers, failure to comply with the sanitary veterinary conditions provided for in the current law is established, primary products direct selling shall be prohibited to small producers carrying out activities of primary products direct selling until improving the deficiencies; they are bound to implement the measures for correcting the established deficiencies and to inform the county sanitary veterinary and food safety authority or that of the municipality of Bucharest when they are corrected.

(4) If primary products direct selling is prohibited to a small producer, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall communicate the decision, where appropriate, to local authorities.

(5) Whenever it is established that there are sufficient reasons to consider that foodstuff involves a risk for public health, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate,

respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall implement measures for the withdrawal from human consumption of the respective foodstuff and it shall notify through the Rapid Alert System, according to the provisions of the current national law.

Article 8

(1) The activities of primary products direct selling may be carried out only by complying with the sanitary veterinary conditions, according to the requirements of the law in this field.

(2) Small producers of primary products subject to direct selling are bound to inform as soon as possible the competent sanitary veterinary and food safety authority whenever they establish that a primary product shows a risk for public health.

Article 9

The primary products direct selling shall be prohibited to small producers not registered by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorates, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

CHAPTER II

Retail sales

1. Definitions

Article 10

These provisions establish the definitions relating to retail sale and the procedure for sanitary veterinary and food safety registration of the activities of retail sale of certain products of animal and non animal origin.

Article 11

Within the meaning of this Chapter, the subsequent terms and expressions are defined as follows:

a) retail sale – the restricted, localized and limited supply of food products of animal and non-animal origin, obtained in establishments authorized from the sanitary veterinary point of view or/and obtained in small quantities in retail disposal establishments at the production place and that are marketed directly towards:

1. the final consumer at the production place;
2. other retail establishments, belonging to the producer, situated on the territory of the respective county, without going beyond the county surface limits;
3. public food establishments in town or in a neighbouring town from the same county;
4. the final consumer, during fairs, markets, exhibitions, religious holidays etc., periodically organized by local authorities.

This concept includes handling and/or processing of food and its storage in the points of sale or delivery towards the final consumer, including distribution terminals, catering operations, canteens, restaurants and other operations similar in the field of food services, shops, supermarket-like distribution centres, wholesale selling markets.

The retail sale activities shall imply disposal of the products of animal and non-animal origin directly towards the final consumer, as well as disposal only in small quantities of the products obtained within the establishment and destined for marketing towards the final consumer through other retail establishments;

b) sanitary veterinary and food safety registration – the registration of establishments in the lists of retail establishments by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety authority, pursuant to a written request from the beneficiary;

c) activities subject to sanitary veterinary and food safety registration – the retail sale activities subject to sanitary veterinary and food safety control and registration, carried out by the establishments provided for in Chapter II of Annex 1;

d) restricted supply – the disposal in small quantities of food products towards the final consumer through other retail establishments;

e) localized supply – the disposal of food products on the territory of the respective county, not requiring a special surveillance, especially concerning the transportation conditions and the compliance with the cold chain;

f) limited supply – obtaining at the selling place of a category of food products destined for disposal towards the final consumer through other retail establishments;

g) retail establishments – the establishments subject to sanitary veterinary and food safety registration, contained in Annex 1, functioning pursuant to the sanitary veterinary and food safety registration document issued by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, according to the model provided for in Annex 3;

h) small quantities – the following quantities of products of animal origin obtained in the retail establishment and destined for sale towards the final consumer through other retail establishments:

1. prepared meat and meat products – up to 2 000 kg/week;

2. milk and milk products – up to 1 000 kg/week;

3. fish and fishery products – up to 1 000 kg/week;

4. wild game and wild game products – up to 300 kg/month;

5. poultry meat, lagomorphs and products derived therefrom – up to 300 kg/month;

6. snails and molluscs – up to 500 kg/month;

7. table eggs – up to 1 000 eggs/month;

i) official retention – the procedure through which the competent authority imposes that food should not be moved or falsified until a decision regarding their destination is made; this includes storage by the processors active in the field of food, according to the directions of competent authorities.

2. Sanitary veterinary and food safety registration of retail sale activities

Article 12

(1) The activities in the retail establishments specified in Annex 1 shall be carried out pursuant to the confirmation of company details issued by the Register of Companies and to the sanitary veterinary and food safety registration document, provided for in Annex 3, issued by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(2) The sanitary veterinary or food safety registration of the activities in the retail establishments specified in Annex 1 shall be carried out by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

Article 13

In view of obtaining the sanitary veterinary and food safety registration document for the activities in the retail establishments provided for in Annex 1, the owner/legal representative of the establishment shall submit at the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, the confirmation of company details issued by the Register of Companies and a written request specifying:

a) name and address of the establishment;

b) activity carried out;

c) types and quantities of products subject to retail sale;

d) places of retail sale of the products obtained in own establishment;

e) number of working staff.

Article 14

(1) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall register the request submitted and shall check, through the official veterinarians/food safety officers, the compliance with the requirements in the field and with those provided for in the Government Decision No 924/2005 on the approval of the General Rules for food hygiene, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 804 of 5 September 2005, representing the transposition in the national law of the provisions of Regulation No 852/2004/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union.

(2) The official veterinarians/food safety officers shall draw up on the spot a food inspection report, containing the conclusion of the assessment.

Article 15

(1) For the retail establishments complying with the sanitary veterinary and food safety requirements, according to the law in the field, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall issue the sanitary veterinary and food safety registration document, according to the model contained in Annex 3.

(2) The retail establishments shall be registered by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorates, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, in a special register, providing each establishment with a registration number, preceded by the letters RS (retail sale).

(3) If, after the checking carried out by the official veterinarians/food safety officers, failure to comply with the sanitary veterinary or food safety conditions is established, a note/a food inspection report shall be drawn up where all the deficiencies established, measures to be implemented, as well as time-limits for improving the deficiencies, shall be written down, under the signature of the legal representative of the establishment.

(4) At the end of the time limit for improving deficiencies, the legal representative of the establishment shall require the recheck of the establishment at the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(5) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall monitor the retail sale activities and shall inform the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority, upon its request.

(6) The small producers carrying out retail sale activities shall be deleted from the list of those registered when it shall be established that they, repeatedly, do not comply with the sanitary veterinary and food safety conditions established by the current law.

(7) The products of animal origin obtained in retail establishments, destined for marketing, must have on the label the following inscription: "PRODUCED IN OWN ESTABLISHMENT", followed by the establishment registration number.

3. Controls, measures and penalties

Article 16

(1) The activities in the establishments provided for in Annex 1 are subject to sanitary veterinary or food safety control by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(2) If, during the controls carried out, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall establish that the legal operating conditions are not complied with, it shall notify this to the person responsible for the establishment and it may impose the following measures:

- a) civil sanction according to the legal provisions into force;
- b) suspension of the activity for which the conditions are not complied with;
- c) prohibition to carry out the activity for which the sanitary veterinary and food safety conditions are not complied with, as provided for in the current national law;

d) official seizure or retention.

(3) In case of the temporary suspension of the activity, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, through the official veterinarians/food safety officers, shall write down in the control note drawn up at the establishment the technical reasons for the temporary suspension of the activity and shall issue the ordinance concerning the temporary suspension of the activity, according to the model established in Annex 5.

(4) The time limit for rectifying deficiencies shall start from the day of notification by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, of the legal representative of the establishment and may be extended at his explicit request.

(5) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall cancel the sanitary veterinary and food safety registration document and shall issue the ordinance regarding prohibition of the activity, according to the model provided for in Annex 6, when, during the control actions carried out by the specialized staff, failure to comply with the legal provisions for which the establishments were registered is established.

(6) In case of retail establishments whose activity was prohibited, the activity shall be resumed by complying with the registration procedure according to the legal provisions, but only after correcting the discrepancies.

(7) The legal representatives of the establishments must apply the measures for correcting the deficiencies established and require the recheck by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, when the deficiencies have been corrected.

(8) If the activities performed by the establishments contained in Annex 1 are established to be carried out without complying with the sanitary veterinary and food safety conditions, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall issue the ordinance regarding prohibition of the activities according to Annex 6 and shall inform the territorial authorities within the Ministry of Justice, the Ministry of Interior and Administrative Reform, the Ministry of Economy and Finance and the Ministry of Labour, Family and Equal Opportunities.

(9) The retail sale activities are subject, whenever necessary, but at least once a term, to control at the production place or at the direct selling place, carried out by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(10) If, after the controls carried out by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, failure to comply with the sanitary veterinary and food safety conditions provided for in the current law is established, the legal representative of the retail establishment must adopt the measures necessary for correcting the deficiencies established and inform the county sanitary veterinary and food safety authority, when the deficiencies have been corrected.

Article 17

The activities subject to sanitary veterinary and food safety control may be carried out only by complying with the sanitary veterinary and food safety conditions, according to the provisions of the law in the field.

Article 18

In order to issue the sanitary veterinary and food safety registration document of the activity, the tariffs provided for in Annex 4 shall be paid by the legal representative of the establishment when taking the document from the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

Article 19

Disposal of the products towards other retail establishments shall be prohibited in conditions other than those provided for in Article 11 (a).

Article 20

The legal representatives of the establishments subject to registration are bound to notify immediately the county sanitary veterinary and food safety authority, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, regarding every change occurred in the activities carried out.

Article 21

The sanitary veterinary and food safety registration documents, that have not been taken from the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, by the applicants, within a period of 30 days from the date of their issue, shall be cancelled.

CHAPTER III

Production of foodstuffs of non animal origin

1. Definitions

Article 22

These provisions establish the definitions regarding the production of foodstuffs of non animal origin and the food safety registration procedure of the establishments producing foodstuffs of non animal origin.

Article 23

Within the meaning of this Chapter, the subsequent terms are defined as follows:

- a) food safety registration - registration of the establishments producing foodstuffs of non animal origin in the lists of those of primary products direct selling by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety authority, pursuant to a written request from the legal representative of the establishment;
- b) activities subject to food safety registration – activities of processing and/or production of foodstuffs of non animal origin, as well as other related activities, carried out by the establishments provided for in Annex 9, that are subject to registration and control regarding food safety;
- c) document for food safety registration – the document issued by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, for the activities in the establishments subject to registration;
- d) food safety officer – specialized staff within the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority, with powers and responsibilities, according to the job description, in checking the compliance with the provisions of the law regarding food safety and in applying the corresponding measures;
- e) county food safety departments/services, respectively those of the municipality of Bucharest – the decentralised food safety public services, technically and administratively subordinated to the Directorate-General for Food Safety within the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority, with the power and responsibility to apply the regulatory actions referring to food safety on the territory of the respective county, to carry out and monitor the control of the public activity for food safety at this level, as well as other powers delegated by the central sanitary veterinary and food safety authority;
- f) official control – any form of control carried out by the competent authority for verification of the conformity with the food safety law;
- g) official retention – the procedure through which the competent authority imposes that products of non animal origin should not be moved or falsified until a decision regarding their

destination is made; this includes storage by the processors active in the field of products of non animal origin according to the directions of competent authorities;

h) official retention form – document issued by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, according to the model provided for in Annex 7;

i) inspection report of the food safety conditions – document to be filled in during the control carried out in every food establishment, according to the model provided for in Annex 8.

2. Food safety registration of the establishments processing products of non animal origin Article 24

(1) The food activities performed by the establishments contained in Annex 9 shall be carried out pursuant to the declaration at one's own risk, the confirmation of company details issued by the Register of Companies and pursuant to the food safety registration document, issued by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(2) The registration of the food activities performed by the establishments contained in Annex 9 shall be carried out by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

Article 25

In view of obtaining the registration document for the food activities carried out by the establishments contained in Annex 9, the applicants shall submit at the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, the confirmation of company details issued by the Register of Companies and a written request specifying:

- a) name and address of the establishment;
- b) activity carried out;
- c) types and quantities of products obtained after processing;
- d) number of working staff.

Article 26

(1) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall register the request submitted, shall issue the registration document according to the model contained in Annex 10 and it shall subsequently check through its food safety officers the compliance with the requirements in the field and with those provided for in the Government Decision No 924/2005, representing the transposition in the national law of the provisions of Regulation No 852/2004/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union.

(2) The establishments provided for in Annex 9 shall be registered by the county food safety departments/services, respectively those of the municipality of Bucharest, within the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorates, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, in a special register.

(3) If, after the checking of the establishment, carried out by the food safety officer, failure to comply with the food safety conditions provided for in the law in the field is established, the inspection report provided for in Annex 8, containing all the deficiencies established, the measures to be implemented, as well as the time-limits for improving the deficiencies, shall be drawn up, under the signature of the legal representative of the establishment.

(4) At the end of the time limit for improving the deficiencies, the legal representative of the establishment shall require the recheck of the establishment at the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest. If the deficiencies established are not corrected within the establishment, the county sanitary veterinary and food

safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall issue the ordinance for the suspension of the activity or, where appropriate, for its prohibition.

(5) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall monitor the food activities carried out by the establishments provided for in Annex 9 and shall inform the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority, upon its request.

(6) The establishments carrying out food activities, provided for in Annex 9, may be deleted from the list of those registered when it shall be established that they, repeatedly, do not comply with the food safety conditions established by the current law.

3. Controls, measures and penalties

Article 27

(1) All the activities in the establishments provided for in Annex 9 are subject to the food safety control by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest.

(2) If, during the controls carried out, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, establishes that the legal operating conditions are not complied with, it shall notify this to the legal representative of the establishment and may impose the following measures:

- a) civil sanction according to the legal provisions into force;
- b) official retention;
- c) suspension of the activity for which the conditions are not complied with;
- d) prohibition to carry out the activity for which the food safety conditions are not complied with, as provided for in the current national law.

(3) In case of suspension of the activity, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, through its specialized officers, shall write down in the inspection report drawn up at the establishment the technical reason for the suspension of the activity and shall issue the ordinance concerning the suspension of the activity, according to the model established in Annex 5.

(4) The time limit for improving the deficiencies shall start from the date of notification by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, of the legal representative of the establishment and may be extended at his explicit request.

(5) The county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall cancel the food safety registration document and shall issue the ordinance regarding prohibition of the activity, according to the model provided for in Annex 6, when, during the control actions carried out by the specialized officers, failure to comply with the legal provisions for which the establishments were registered is established.

(6) In case of the establishments provided for in Annex 9 whose activity was prohibited, the activity shall be resumed by complying with the registration procedure according to the legal provisions, but only after correcting the discrepancies.

(7) The legal representatives of the establishment must apply the measures for correcting the deficiencies established and require the recheck by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, when the deficiencies are corrected.

(8) If the activities performed by the establishments contained in Annex 9 are established to be carried out without a food safety registration, the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, shall notify the establishment in written that it should register as soon as possible, otherwise, within 30 days from the notification

the ordinance concerning prohibition of the activities shall be issued, this being subsequently communicated to the territorial authorities within the Ministry of Justice, the Ministry of Interior and Administrative Reform, the Ministry of Economy and Finance and the Ministry of Labour, Family and Equal Opportunities.

(9) If, after the controls carried out by the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, failure to comply with the food safety conditions provided for in the current law is established, the legal representatives of the establishments involved in the food activities carried out by the establishments provided for in Annex 9 must apply the measures necessary for correcting the deficiencies established and inform the county authority, when the deficiencies are corrected.

Article 28

The activities subject to food safety control shall be carried out during the compliance with the food safety conditions, according to the requirements of the law in the field.

Article 29

The processing of the products of non animal origin by other establishments in conditions other than those provided for in this sanitary veterinary and food safety rule shall be prohibited.

Article 30

The legal representatives of the establishments subject to registration are bound to notify immediately the county sanitary veterinary and food safety authority, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, regarding every change occurred in the activities carried out.

Article 31

The food safety registration documents, that have not been taken from the county sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate, respectively that of the municipality of Bucharest, by the applicants, within a period of 30 days from the date of their issue, shall be cancelled.

Article 32

The Annexes 1-10 are part of this sanitary veterinary and food safety rule.

ANNEX 1

to the sanitary veterinary and food safety rule

CHAPTER I

RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS SUBJECT TO SANITARY VETERINARY REGISTRATION AND CONTROL

1. Meat:

a) Butchery: establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception of meat from establishments authorized from the sanitary veterinary point of view, its storage and cutting, the production of minced meat, of prepared meat and/or meat products in a restricted range of varieties (smoked sausages, smoked loin without tenderloin, smoked solid outer pig fat, smoked ribs, smoked ham), in small quantities, and retail sale directly towards:

- (i) the final consumer at the production place;
- (ii) other retail establishments, belonging to the producer, situated on the territory of the respective county, without going beyond the county surface limits;
- (iii) public food establishments in town or in a neighbouring town;
- (iv) the final consumer during fairs, markets, exhibitions, religious holidays, etc., periodically organized by county/local authorities.

b) Slaughterhouse: establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception of meat from establishments authorized from the sanitary veterinary point of view, its storage, boning, cutting into portions and retail sale towards the final consumer;

2. Milk and milk products:

Milk processing centre: establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception of milk as feedstock, obtained from the local producers, its storage, production of milk products – “urdă” (soft cheese from whey), curd, fresh cheese, “brânză de burduf” (traditional kneaded cheese), cream, fresh “telemea” cheese (white cheese in brine) - in small quantities, and retail sale directly towards:

- a) the final consumer at the production place;
- b) other retail establishments, belonging to the producer, situated on the territory of the respective county, without going beyond the county surface limits;
- c) public food establishments in town or in a neighbouring town from the same county;
- d) the final consumer, during fairs, markets, exhibitions, religious holidays, etc., periodically organized by local authorities.

This category also includes areas and facilities at the level of sheepfolds or farms, situated in geographical areas difficult in access, where milk as feedstock from animals in own farms shall be processed and marketed directly towards the final consumer during fairs, markets, exhibitions, religious holidays, etc., periodically organized by local authorities.

3. Fish and fishery products:

a) Fish collection centre: establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception, sorting, scraping, storage, cooling and primary processing of fish directly from fishing – scaling, evisceration, fin cutting, packaging, cooling and delivery of the products obtained towards an establishment authorized from the sanitary veterinary point of view or retail sale directly towards:

- (i) the final consumer at the production place;
- (ii) other retail establishments;
- (iii) public food establishments in town or in a neighbouring town from the same county;
- (iv) the final consumer during fairs, markets, exhibitions, religious holidays, etc., periodically organized by local authorities.

b) Fishing craft: any small-sized ship or craft equipped for catching and storage of wild or aquaculture fish for a short period of time, destined for an establishment registered/authorized from the veterinary point of view, or direct selling towards the final consumer at the landing point.

c) Landing point: any place open to sea, with equipments and facilities for berthing of fishing crafts where the reception, sorting, cooling and storage of fresh fish from fishing, destined for an establishment registered/authorized from the veterinary point of view, or direct selling towards the final consumer at the landing point, are carried out.

d) Fish selling shop (Fishmonger's): establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception and storage of fish and fishery products from establishments registered/authorized from the veterinary point of view or directly from fishing, primary processing of fresh fish directly from fishing, retail sale towards the final consumer;

e) Centre for collecting batrachians, gastropods, crustaceans etc.: establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations where activities are carried out for their reception, cooling, storage and delivery towards a processor authorized from the veterinary point of view or to another retail establishment;

4. Honey and other honey products:

a) Centre for the extraction and collection of honey and other products produced by bees: set or mobile establishment with adequate facilities where activities are carried out for the reception, extraction, storage and delivery of bee honey and other products produced by bees towards an establishment authorized from the veterinary point of view for processing, or towards the final consumer;

b) Apiary: set or mobile establishment where apiary activities are carried out including the production of bee honey and other products produced by bees and their delivery towards an establishment registered/authorized from the veterinary point of view for processing, or towards the final consumer;

c) Selling shop for bee honey and other products produced by bees: establishment with limited facilities where activities are carried out for keeping bee honey and other products produced by bees from establishments authorized from the veterinary point of view, their presentation and selling to the final consumer, packed and/or pre-packed by the producer.

CHAPTER II

RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS SUBJECT TO SANITARY VETERINARY AND FOOD SAFETY REGISTRATION AND CONTROL

1. Public food or food marketing establishments:

a) Restaurant (irrespective of the type): public premises including adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception of the products of animal and non animal origin, storage, preparation and service on the premises of ready-to-eat and food products or delivery in small quantities by order of ready-to-eat and food products, pastry products/sugar confectioneries and other similar products;

This category also includes: cafeterias, restaurant cars, caravans, fast food, bars, as well as all types of establishments where food mentioned in point (a) is prepared and served.

b) Pizzeria: establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception and storage of feedstock of animal and non animal origin, preparation, packaging, where appropriate, and selling, including by order, of different types of pizza and other prepared food.

c) Canteen: establishment with organized areas where activities are carried out for the reception and storage of feedstock of animal and non animal origin, preparation of menus and serving of the meals to the final consumer on the premises or by order.

d) Confectionery and/or pastry laboratory: establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations where activities are carried out for the reception of feedstock of animal and non animal origin, their storage and processing into sugar confectioneries/pastry products, their storage and delivery towards other retail establishments or through the own shop.

e) Boarding houses: establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the production, reception and storage of feedstock of animal and non animal origin, preparation and service on the premises of cooked food;

f) Food store: establishment with limited facilities where activities are carried out for the limited keeping, presentation and separate selling of products of animal and non animal origin, packed and/or pre-packed by the producer;

g) Hypermarket/supermarket: establishment with distinct storage areas and capacities where activities are carried out for the reception, distinct storage and selling in separate departments of the products of animal and non animal origin, including cutting, preparation and packaging of meat only if this activity represents less than 20% of the activity of the entire objective;

h) Online selling establishments: establishment with set or mobile areas and facilities for the storage, transportation towards the final consumer and selling only by online order of feedstock of animal and non animal origin packed and/or pre-packed by the producer;

2. Establishments with other activities in the field:

a) Food deposit: establishment with adequate areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception of products of animal and non animal origin without thermal condition, derived from establishments registered/authorized from the veterinary and food safety point of view, their storage and delivery towards other establishments or directly to the final consumer;

b) Catering: establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations where activities are carried out for the reception of feedstock of animal and non animal origin, its storage and processing into products destined for disposal towards other retail establishments and/or to the final consumer.

c) Station for the cleaning and disinfection of means of transport: establishment with corresponding areas and equipments where activities are carried out for the cleaning, washing and disinfection of the means of transport, of the products of animal origin.

I. Activities for processing and storing fruit and vegetables

1. Establishments for the processing of prepared or frozen potatoes – establishment with adequate areas and facilities for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of the prepared potatoes or equipped with refrigeration areas for processing frozen potatoes, as well as other areas for the storage, delivery of plant products.

2. Establishments for the production of dried mashed potatoes – establishment with adequate areas, facilities, adequate installations for the reception, storage, processing of dried potatoes, in view of obtaining mashed potatoes.

3. Establishments for the production of potato snacks – establishments with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of potatoes, in view of obtaining the snack production and their service.

4. Production establishments for making chip potatoes – establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of

potatoes, in view of obtaining the chip potatoes production, as well as for their packaging and delivery.

5. Production establishments for making potato flour – establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of potatoes, in view of obtaining potato flour, as well as its packaging, storage, keeping and delivery.

6. Establishments for the production of fruit and vegetable juices – establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of fruit and vegetables in view of obtaining juices therefrom, as well as areas and facilities necessary for bottling, packaging, storage, keeping and delivery thereof.

7. Establishments for the production of fruit and vegetable concentrates – establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of fruit and vegetables in view of obtaining concentrates therefrom, as well as areas and facilities necessary for bottling, packaging, storage, keeping and delivery thereof.

8. Establishments for the conservation of fruit, walnuts or vegetables - establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing (freezing, drying, oil or vinegar conservation, canning, etc.) in view of conserving fruit and vegetables, as well as areas, including refrigeration areas and facilities necessary for bottling, packaging, storage, keeping and delivery thereof.

9. Establishments for the production of fruit and vegetable foodstuffs – establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of fruit and vegetables, in view of obtaining foodstuffs, as well as areas necessary for their storage and delivery.

10. Establishments for the production of jams, marmalades and jellies – establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation and processing of fruit and vegetables, in view of obtaining jams, marmalades and jellies, as well as for their packaging, storage and delivery.

II. Activities for the production of vegetable and animal oils and fats

1. Establishments for the production of unprocessed vegetable oils (olive, sunflower, soya, rapeseed, flax, marrow seeds oils, etc.) - establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation, processing of feedstock in view of obtaining unprocessed oils and fats, as well as areas necessary for their storage and delivery.

2. Establishments for the production of fatty oilseed flour - establishment with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage, market preparation, processing of feedstock in view of obtaining fat oleaginous flour, its storage and delivery.

3. Establishments for the production of refined vegetable oils (olive oil, soya oil, etc.) - establishments with adequate areas, facilities, installations for the reception, storage and processing of feedstock in view of obtaining refined vegetable oils, as well as areas necessary for their bottling, storage and delivery.

4. Establishments for the processing of vegetable oils – establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations for the storage and processing of vegetable oils (through blowing, boiling, oxidation, polymerization, drying, hydrogenation, etc.), as well as areas necessary for their bottling, storage and delivery.

5. Establishments for the production of margarine – establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations for the reception, storage and processing of feedstock, for the production of margarine, as well as areas necessary for its storage and delivery.

6. Establishments for the production of mixtures for sandwiches - establishment with organized areas, facilities and installations for the reception and separate storage of feedstock of

vegetable and animal origin, in view of producing mixtures for sandwiches, as well as areas necessary for their storage and delivery.

7. Establishments for the production of combined cooking fats - establishment with organized areas, facilities and installations for the reception and storage of feedstock, in view of producing combined cooking fats, as well as areas necessary for their storage and delivery.

III. Activities for the preparation of products of the milling industry, starch and starch products

1. Establishments of the milling industry – specialized establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception, storage, processing of cereal grains and their processing into feedstock for bread establishments (flour, pearl barley, wheat groats or pellets, rye, oat, maize or other cereals production), as well as areas for the storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

2. Establishments for grinding rice - specialized establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception, storage, processing of rice grains in view of obtaining ground, glazed, semi-boiled rice or rice meal production, as well as areas for the storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

3. Establishments for grinding vegetables - specialized establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception, storage, sorting, processing and grinding of vegetables in view of obtaining flours and meals of dried vegetables or edible fruit and nuts, as well as areas for the storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

4. Establishments for the production of breakfast cereals - specialized establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception, storage, processing through heat treatment of cereals by expanding thereof in view of obtaining breakfast cereals, as well as areas for the storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

5. Establishments for the production of flour in mixture - specialized establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception, storage, blending flour in view of obtaining flour in mixture for bread, cakes, biscuits or pancakes, as well as areas for the storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

6. Establishments for the production of starch - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception of feedstock (rice, potatoes, maize, wheat, etc.), storage, processing by grinding, germination, extraction, purifying-refining, dehydration, drying, in view of obtaining starch, as well as areas for the packaging, storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

7. Establishments for the production of glucose, glucose syrup, maltose - specialized establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception of feedstock (starch suspension from potatoes and maize), storage, processing through hydrolysis in view of obtaining glucose syrup, total sugar, crystallized dextrose anhydrous, isosyrup, crystallized dextrose monohydrate, fructose, maltose, as well as areas for the packaging, storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

8. Establishments for the production of gluten - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception of feedstock, storage, processing by extraction, separation, concentration, dehydration, drying in view of obtaining gluten, as well as areas for the packaging, storage, keeping and delivery of the finished good.

9. Establishments for the production of maize germ oil - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field for the reception of feedstock, storage, processing of maize germ in view of obtaining oil, as well as areas for its bottling, storage, keeping and delivery.

IV. Activities for the production of other foodstuffs

1. Establishments for the production of bread, fresh pastry products, pies, bread specialties, cakes, tarts, etc. - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field, including refrigeration areas for the reception of feedstock, storage, processing of flour and ingredients of vegetable and animal origin in view of obtaining fresh pastry products, pies, bread specialties, cakes, tarts, etc, as well as areas for the corresponding storage and delivery.

2. Establishments for the production of biscuits, champagne biscuits, dry pastry products, conserved pastry products and cakes, and for the production of sweet or salted snack products - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field, including refrigeration areas for the reception of feedstock, storage, processing of feedstock of animal and vegetable origin in view of producing biscuits, champagne biscuits, dry pastry products, conserved pastry products and cakes, and for the production of sweet or salted snack products, as well as areas for the corresponding storage, keeping and delivery.

3. Establishments for the production and refining of sugar and substitutes in sugar beet, sugar cane, maple and palm juice - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field appropriate for the reception of feedstock, its storage and processing in view of obtaining, storing, and delivering sugar.

4. Establishments for the production of cocoa products, chocolate, sugar confectionery, including cocoa butter, cocoa fat and oil, chewing gum, sugar conservation of fruit, fruit stones and other plant parts, production of pellets and lozenges (mentholated such as TIC TAC) - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field, for the reception of feedstock (cocoa, chocolate, sugar, fruit), storage, processing of feedstock of vegetable and animal origin in view of obtaining cocoa products, chocolate, sugar confectionery, including cocoa butter, cocoa fat and oil, chewing gum, sugar conservation of fruit, fruit stones and other plant parts, production of pellets and lozenges (mentholated such as TIC TAC), as well as areas for the corresponding storage and delivery.

5. Establishments for the production of macaronis, noodles, couscous, pasta products and other similar pasta products - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field, for the reception, storage, processing of feedstock and ingredients of vegetable and animal origin in view of obtaining macaronis, noodles, couscous, pasta products and other similar pasta products, as well as areas for the corresponding storage and delivery.

6. Establishments for the processing of coffee - establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field, for the reception of feedstock, storage, areas for processing coffee by decaffeination and roasting in view of obtaining ground coffee, soluble coffee, coffee extracts and concentrates, production of coffee substitutes, as well as areas for the corresponding packaging, storage and delivery.

7. Establishments for the processing of tea – establishment equipped with areas, appliances, facilities and installations in the field, for the reception of feedstock, storage, areas for the processing of tea and plant leaves, packaging of tea, including in sachets (tea bags), production of plant infusions (mint, camomile, verbena, etc.), as well as areas for the corresponding packaging, storage and delivery.

8. Establishments for the production of spices – specialized establishment with areas for the reception and storage of feedstock, areas and facilities for the production of flavours, ketchup, spicy sauces, spices, mayonnaise, mustard flour, mustard and vinegar, areas for the packaging, storage and delivery of the finished goods.

9. Establishments for the production of homogenized and dietetic foodstuffs – establishment equipped with areas, facilities and installations for the reception, storage and production of foodstuffs for special nutritional uses, of infant milk powder, milk and other

powders for infants, infant food, low calories foodstuffs, dietetic foodstuffs for special medical purposes, low sodium foodstuffs, including salt free of sodium, foodstuffs free of gluten, foodstuffs recommended for intense muscle effort, respectively for athletes, foodstuffs for people suffering from carbohydrate metabolism disorders (diabetes), as well as areas appropriate for the packaging, storage and delivery of the finished goods.

10. Establishments for making other products not classified elsewhere – establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations for the reception of feedstock, storage and production of soups, borsch, production of bakers' yeast, of foodstuffs enriched by trace elements, vitamins, proteins, of food and nutritional supplements, as well as areas appropriate for the packaging, storage and delivery of the finished goods.

11. Establishments for the production of frozen foodstuffs – establishments with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception of feedstock, storage and production of deep-frozen products, as well as areas for the corresponding packaging, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

12. Establishments for the production of dried foodstuffs – establishments with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception of feedstock, storage and production of dried foodstuffs, as well as areas for the corresponding packaging, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

V. Activities for the production of beverages

1. Establishments for the production of distillate alcoholic beverages – establishment with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception, storage of feedstock and semi-finished products and production of distillate alcoholic beverages: whisky, brandy, gin, liqueurs and cordials, as well as areas appropriate for their bottling, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

2. Establishments for the production of fermentation ethyl alcohol – establishment with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception, storage of feedstock, semi-finished products and their processing in view of obtaining fermentation ethyl alcohol and neutral alcohols, as well as areas appropriate for their bottling, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

3. Establishments for the production of wine – establishment with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception and storage of feedstock, semi-finished products and their processing in view of obtaining wine, table wine, quality wine produced in specified regions (quality wine p.s.r.), sparkling wine, concentrated grape must wine and low alcohol wine or de-alcoholised wine, as well as areas appropriate for their bottling, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

4. Establishments for the production of cider and other fruit wines – establishment with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception of feedstock, storage and production of cider, perry, mead and other fruit wines, and mixed beverages containing alcohol, as well as areas appropriate for their storage, bottling and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

5. Establishments for the production of other non distillate beverages obtained by fermentation – establishment with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception and storage of feedstock, semi-finished products and their processing in view of obtaining vermouth and other similar beverages, as well as areas appropriate for their bottling, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

6. Establishments for the production of beer - establishment with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception and storage of feedstock and ingredients for the

production of beer, as well as areas for its bottling, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

7. Malt house – is the department within the beerhouse where germination of barley and other cereals is carried out in view of obtaining malt.

8. Establishments for the production of mineral waters and non alcoholic soft drinks – establishment with areas, facilities and installations for the intake, carbonation, bottling of mineral water, production of non alcoholic soft drinks, aromatized and/or sweetened non alcoholic beverages: lemonade, orange juice, cola, energy drinks, fruit beverages, tonic waters, as well as areas appropriate for their bottling, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

VI. Other activities

1. Establishments for the packaging of foodstuffs of non animal origin - establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations where activities are carried out for the reception, storage, packaging and delivery of foodstuffs of non animal origin.

2. Deposit for consumer seed - establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations where activities are carried out for the reception, storage and delivery of consumer seed.

3. Food deposit for products of non animal origin - establishment with adequate areas, facilities and installations where activities are carried out for the reception, storage and delivery of pre-packed products of non animal origin, both for other establishments and final consumer.

4. Cold storage for foodstuffs of non animal origin - establishment with appropriate cold areas and facilities where activities are carried out for the reception, storage and delivery of frozen products of non animal origin or requiring low storage temperatures, both for other establishments and final consumer.

5. Establishments for the marketing of frozen foodstuffs – establishments with areas, facilities and installations appropriate for the reception of feedstock, storage and/or processing of deep-frozen products, as well as areas for the corresponding packaging, storage and delivery, both for other establishments and final consumer.

6. Establishments for the production of packagings for food products communicating with foodstuffs – establishments with adequate areas, facilities and installations for the corresponding production of packagings for food products communicating with foodstuffs, as well as areas for their corresponding packaging, storage and delivery, for the establishments using them.

7. Means of transport for products of non animal origin: any ship, aircraft, vehicle etc. registered as means of transport properly equipped so that the products of non animal origin do not modify during transportation their characteristics mentioned in the accompanying documents;
